	Cider Maker	Name	ABV %	Origin	Style	Tasting Notes
1	Aspall	Ciderkyns	3.8	Suffolk	Sweet	Slightly sweet with dry finish. Clean aroma of fresh green apples & toffee.
2	Burnard's	Gold Dust	6.8	Norfolk	Sweet	Sweet, slightly cloudy with citrus flavours. A little dryness & honey in the finish.
3	Burnard's	Oakey Dokey	5.2	Norfolk	Sweet	Sweet and clear, light and golden. Apple, fruit, wood and rum aromas. Tangy with an incredible amount of woody flavours. Medium sour finish.
4	Cambridge Cider Co	Much Merriment	6.7	Cambridgeshire	Sweet	An easy drinking sweet cider made from dessert and culinary apples.
5	Hallets	National Treasure	5.0	Monmouthshire	Sweet	Created from three classic cider apples, full flavoured with a citrus backnote.
6	Harleston Cider Co	Hedge Fund	5.0	Suffolk	Sweet	A derivative of Cideroad. A sweet, fruity cider with a green apple finish.
7	Hecks	Dabinett *	6.5	Somerset	Sweet	Apple discovered by William Dabinett of Somerset, producing a high quality and rounded cider, with a sweet fruity astringency. One for the connoisseur!
8	Hecks	Dunkerton's Late Sweet *	6.5	Somerset	Sweet	Raised by Mr Dunkerton of Baltonsborough and a traditional variety for its area, this is a honeyed fruity smooth cider, perfect for that lazy hazy summer's day picnic.
9	Millwhites	Rum Cask	7.5	Somerset	Sweet	West Country cider apples aged in Jamaican Rum Company barrels. Full of fruit flavour with a subtle rum finish, 't'will ave your legs away!'
10	Snails Bank	Orchard Dry	5.2	Herefordshire	Sweet	Dabinett apples and other traditional bitter sweets such as Harry Masters and Ellis Bitter producing a sweet and crisp balance.
11	Spinney Abbey	Dirty Habit	4.0	Cambridgeshire	Sweet	Sweet cider, flavoured with honey to make it ultra smooth and easy drinking.
12	Glebe Farm	Side-R Strawberry	6.0	Cambridgeshire	Med Sweet	Made from Cambridgeshire eating & cooking apple varieties, fully fermented out, sweetened with apple juice & flavoured with natural elderflower cordial.
13	Harleston Cider Co	Cideroad	4.6	Suffolk	Med Sweet	So named as some apples have been picked from the sides of the road; Harleston's flagship cider that's light, zingy and refreshing.
14	Hecks	Brown Apple *	6.5	Somerset	Med sweet	Made from classic Brown's Apple bred in Devon, produces a crisp, acidic cider with elderflower overtones.
15	Hecks	Glastonbury Gold	6.5	Somerset	Med Sweet	Made with apples gathered from beneath Glastonbury Tor, this cider is golden in colour, medium sweet with soft tannins.
16	Hecks	Loyal Drain (Red Jersey) *	6.5	Somerset	Med Sweet	Has its roots in the Shepton Mallet area. Lots of tannin and a strong smoky aftertaste, this is a quality bittersweet cider.
17	SO Cider	Barrel No.5	5.2	Cambridgeshire	Med Sweet	A clear cider with deep tanin undertones with a candy apple finish.
18	Spinney Abbey	Monk & Disorderly	5.6	Cambridgeshire	Med Sweet	A crisp and easy drinking sweet cider.
19	Abrahalls	Lily the Pink	4.5	Herefordshire	Medium	A gorgeous delicate pink hue. Made using 100% cider apples, intense fruity aroma.
20	Cambridge Cider Co	Up The Stairs	6.7	Cambridgeshire	Medium	Blend of apples & pears producing a 'Most' which originates from Mostviertel, Austria.
21	Celtic Tiger	Orange & Pineapple	4.0	Herefordshire	Medium	This medium cider is liberally imparted with orange and pineapple - Caribbean sunshine and English countryside combine to provide a refreshing tropical cider.
22	Harleston Cider Co	Ciderlite	4.0	Suffolk	Medium	A festival cider. Easy drinking, refreshing, with clear parallels to a session beer

23	Hecks	Cox's Orange Pippin *	6.5	Somerset	Medium	Delicate and fruity cider from the juice of traditional English origin eating apples. Aromatic flavours.
24	Hecks	Kingston Black *	6.5	Somerset	Medium	The Kingston Black arose in Somerset in the late 19th Century & produces a classic copper-coloured cider. Rounded, almost velvety in texture and is full of flavour.
25	Potton Press	Sweet Spot	7.4	Bedfordshire	Medium	A hazy pale golden cider. Aromas of toffee, apple and cloves. Light sweetness, medium bitterness with sour tinges.
26	Village Green	Norfolk Medium	5.7	Norfolk	Medium	Eastern style unpasteurised & unfiltered cider. Clean & sharp, no bitter apples are used.
27	Burnard's	Monty's Double	6.0	Norfolk	Med dry	Crisp & easy drinking. Orangey pink in colour, from a mix of sweet & sour apples.
28	Cambridge Cider Co	Scratter's Reward	6.9	Cambridgeshire	Med Dry	A crisp, medium dry cider made from a mix of dessert and culinary apples.
29	Cromwell Cider	Oliver's Choice	6.7	Cambridgeshire	Med Dry	A medium dry cider which is light in colour and with a slight residual sparkle and distinct apple flavour is possible.
30	Gwynt y Ddraig	Dog Dancer	6.5	Mid Glamorgan	Med Dry	Smooth, crisp Welsh cider. Light straw coloured, displays a slightly bittersweet & sharp characteristic.
31	Spinney Abbey	Virgin on the Ridiculous	5.6	Cambridgeshire	Med Dry	Medium dry and slightly sour cider.
32	Hecks	Tom Putt *	6.5	Somerset	Dry	From a traditional Devon multi-purpose apple variety classified as mild and sharp. This produces a clean, thin, dry cider.
33	Hecks	Worcester Pearmain *	6.5	Somerset	Dry	Pale slightly cloudy appearance made from a classic dessert apple. Light apple flavour.
34	Potton Press	Trip Hazard	8.2	Bedfordshire	Dry	Rich, strong and characterful! Produced using a traditional granite apple press.
35	SO Cider	Pigeon Scarer	6.5	Cambridgeshire	Dry	Clear, smooth and crisp, traditional East Anglian cider.
36	Village Green	Norfolk Dry	5.9	Norfolk	Dry	A dry, unpasteurised & unfiltered cider. Refreshing with a subtle wine apple flavour.

37	Hecks	Blended Farmhouse Perry	6.0	Somerset	Sweet	A hazy yellow and clear dry funky perry with prominent pear aromas. Hints of chewy toffee and nectar. Sweet but subtle.
38	Black Rat	Perry	7.5	Somerset	Med Sweet	Clear, pale yellow. A vibrant and drinkable perry with true pear aromas. Late dryness.
39	Dudda's Tun	Pear O' Duddas	5.5	Kent	Med Sweet	Hazy, yellow perry. Aromas of pear, spice and caramel. Light bitterness & sharpness.
40	Hecks	Blackeney Red	6.5	Somerset	Med Sweet	Clear and golden coloured. Fruity flavours and aromas full of pear, barnyard, wood and leather. Tartness followed by sweet aftertones.
41	Hecks	Hendre Huffcap	6.0	Somerset	Med Sweet	Misty yellow, medium-sweet still perry made from the Hendre Huffcap pear. Juicy, spicy and fleshy with gentle sweetness.
42	Cromwell Cider	Cavalier Perry	6.5	Cambridgeshire	Medium	Made from Conference and Comice pears that are allowed to fully ripen on the tree to produce a light and bright medium perry.
43	Gwynt y Ddraig	Two Trees	4.5	Mid Glamorgan	Medium	A pale, golden fruity perry with an aroma of fruit and honey. Floral notes and hints of pear drops, straw and apple pie!
